Swim to Rottnest Island without leaving Broome

Keen swimmers who are unable to make it to Perth to tackle WA's biggest open water event can still challenge themselves without leaving Broome.

The Broome Recreation and Aquatic Centre will again host the Virtual Rottnest Channel Swim on Saturday 22 February to coincide with the annual Rottnest Channel Swim.

BRAC Program Development Officer Mark Hubbard said the event involved swimmers and teams of swimmers covering the same 20km distance by completing 800 laps of the BRAC swimming pool.
